All Sections Outlined in Project 2 Description are Included	Student wrote well-written paragraphs addressing each section mandated by the project description. Moreover, each section was written in a manner understandable to any other reader in the class	Student did not address each section with a full paragraph or did not include all required items (such as title page). Either not every section was included, or not every section was thoroughly addressed. One or more sections are either too vague, or would not be understandable to another reader in the class.	No attempt was made to follow the project structure outline given in the Project 2 description. The student clearly didn't take the project seriously.	
Grammar, Spelling, and Punctuation	Writes with no spelling, grammatical, or punctuation errors. All sentences are complete.	Writes with some errors in either spelling, punctuation, or grammar. Some sentences are incomplete.	Writes with errors in spelling, grammar, and punctuation in most sentences. There are several sentence fragments .	
Thorough Description and Documentation of Each Step of the Recipe Size Conversion	The computations for the recipe size conversion were clear, step-by-step, and understandable. Each step was accompanied by a verbal description and reasoning for the calculation.	Either not all steps were well-described, or not thoroughly documented. Descriptions are either vague or unclear, leaving room for uncertainty for a reader who would want to follow the calculations.	Most or all steps are poorly described and/or documented. Not all steps are included specified in the project description.	
Thorough Description and Documentation of Each Step of the Recipe Cost Calculation	The computations for the cost to make the scaled-up recipe were clear, step-by-step, and understandable. Each step was accompanied by a verbal description and reasoning for the calculation.	Either not all steps were well-described, or not thoroughly documented. Descriptions are either vague or unclear, leaving room for uncertainty for a reader who would want to follow the calculations.	Most or all steps are poorly described and/or documented. Not all steps are included specified in the project description.	
Food-Cost Form Filled Out Completely and Correctly	The food cost form was filled out completely with all appropriate units of measure. All computations were performed correctly with no errors in calculations, notation, or units.	There is at least one error in either the computations, use of notation, or units.
