Excellent performance in classroom teaching and respect for students' rights and needs:

Benjamin Holt demonstrates currency and depth of knowledge of teaching of mathematics through an innovative student centered website which enables him to do less lecturing and more interactive work in and outside of class. One student even wrote, "The online mechanism to enhance our learning is amazing." His student centered approach, he admits, is working even better then he originally thought it would.
