	-Some of the homework, as is already known, was too lengthy and/or seemed unreasonably challenging/tedious						
	-l'm not sure if I entirely agree with a homework system where a problem is selected at random and all points are assigned based on that. I am of the opinion that homework shouldn't harm a student, at least not by much, and should instead be an opportunity for students to practice with the material without fear of failing. With the sort of system that may be implemented in future courses, however, I think that such a system might not be the most beneficial. That being said, I think that there should possibly be a change from MyOpenMath. Perhaps a less harsh grading system could be used for the system that may be implemented in subsequent courses.	Q
