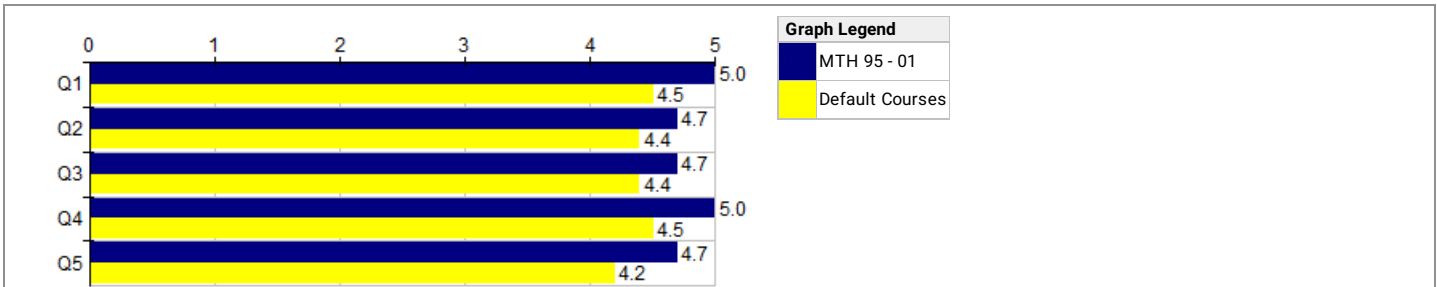
Q6 - Comments regarding your course?

2	My only complaint is that the course seemed crammed into a small time span that doesn't give the concepts justice. The real world applications enhanced my understanding of the respective concepts, but assigning applications to more of the course content would be helpful.

4	I would have to argue that there is very little to critique this term; I believe that everything was done well. Thus, I would like to discuss what seemed to work well and what I found helpful. To start, I found the volume of homework to be very reasonable; there was not a time when I felt overwhelmed by the amount of homework that needed to be accomplished, yet, there was enough to remain busy throughout the week. So, from my point of view, I would argue that a homework assignment is reasonable from 10 to 15(+/-)3 problems depending on the complexity of the material and calculations required. I also found the practice exams to be very helpful; they were a nice refresher for everything we covered over 2 weeks and served as tools to identify how familiar I was with the material. In regards to the material, I would argue that it was presented in an understandable way, which was further reinforced by plenty of real-world applications. If there were anything that I could critique, it might be the types of questions on the homework and maybe how questions are addressed. As it is right now, I think the homework is fine; I have felt mostly prepared for the exams and was able to become more familiar with the material. That being said, I think it would be beneficial to add a couple of conceptual questions that test our knowledge of the core concepts of the material. I know there have been true or false questions, which are more conceptual, but, from what I can remember, they seemed to test our knowledge of 'non-core' ideas. I could be wrong with that statement, but I do think it would be beneficial to have a good understanding of the core concepts of the material that can be reinforced with the homework. Now, I will try to explain what I mean by 'how questions are addressed.' Currently, when we have questions about homework, we state the problem and then work through it, which I don't think there is anything wrong with. However, I have an idea that could be more beneficial: instead of immediately working through the problem, allow the student to work through the problem first. This way, the student can explain their thinking and thus their understanding of the material, and you would be able to identify where they are making their mistake. Although, I guess one potential problem with this is that it could take too long or the mistake could end up being a simple sign error or algebraic mishap. Overall, I think this term went really well and I am very satisfied with the course and knowledge I now have. So, thank you for that, and thank you for being very reasonable and amiable.

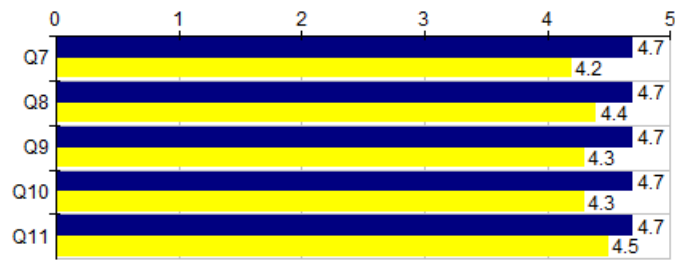

3	Excellent teacher, nice guy who makes the lectures fun and insightful, and I personally hate math. 

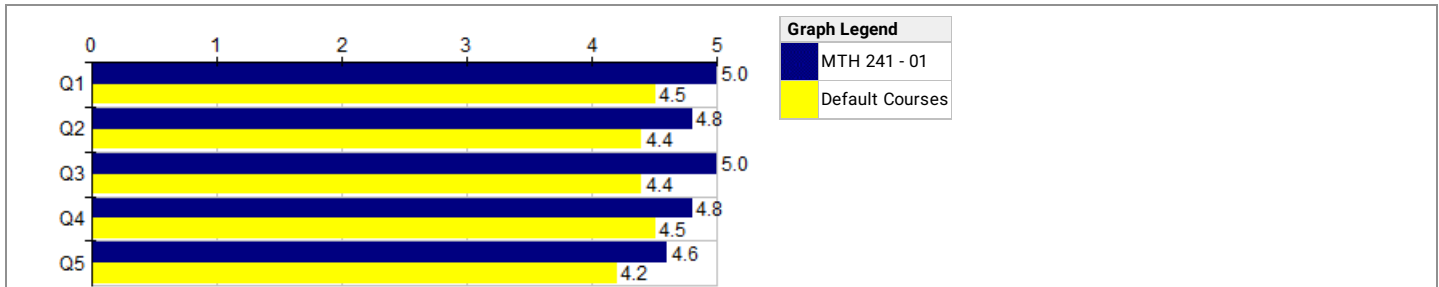

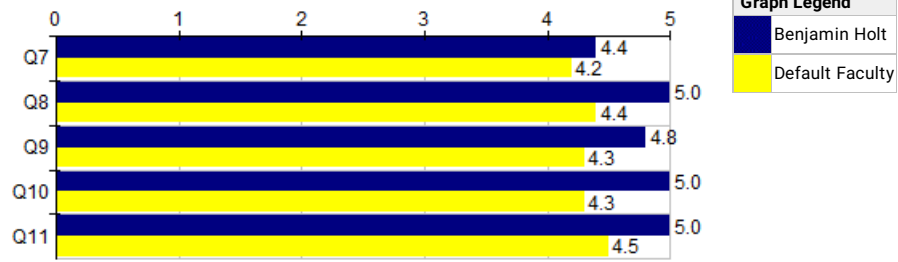
